I am writing to provide you with an update on the construction of the new liquor distribution centre in St. Albert. It's been a year since we broke ground on the building site, and I'm pleased to let you know that the work on the site has been progressing very well. Land development is still underway, including underground services, storm water management, and site grading.

The new building will help the AGLC to accommodate the current as well as future product volumes. As the plans for the building have evolved over the last year, the decision was made to build according to the original square footage. With efficiency being top of mind as we continue with this project, we have ensured that the overall design concept can help us meet the market needs once the building is operational, while allowing the facility to grow as required by the market conditions.

We are expecting the construction to start by early 2016. The estimated construction time is two years. The new distribution centre will be operating in conjunction with the current main warehouse in St. Albert, which will allow for the most efficient and economical handling of liquor products.
